

TIPS FOR CHOOSING AN AGENT/AGENCY

The cost of a private Medicare plan remains consistent and is determined by factors such as the carrier, zip code, and plan selection— and is not based upon which agent/agency you utilize. What we pay for Medicare is highly regulated, it is a little different from homeowners' or care insurance (where if you change your agent, you may find a lower price), choosing a different agent or agency does not affect the cost of a Medicare Plan.

Given the cost each plan is static, regardless of which Agent/Agency you choose, please take the following points into consideration:

- 1.) Is the Agent/Agency knowledgeable about how Medicare works?
- 2.) When you contact an agency or agent about starting your Medicare benefits, will they guide you through the application process or simply direct you to call Medicare for help?
- 3.) Navigating the Medicare filing process can be challenging, particularly when Medicare requests additional information and advises you to contact your agent or agency for further guidance.
- 4.) After enrollment, will the Agent or Agency answer your call and help with your issue?
